 Sterling, Item 4th To my daughter Sarah Hardy five Shillings Sterling
 Item 5th To my son Abraham Bonnett five Shillings Sterling
 Item 6th To my daughter Lucy Hardy five Shillings Sterling
 Item 7th To my daughter Polly Perry Hardy dollars
 Item 8th To my daughter Mary Bonnett twenty dollars
 Item 9th To my son Thomas Bonnett one cow & half feather bed & furniture
 Item 10th To my son Asa Bonnett one horse bridle & saddle one cow & half
 feather bed & furniture, Item 11th My sons William Bonnett and
 Bartholomew Bonnett Thomas Bonnett & Asa Bonnett I give and
 bequeath to my beloved four sons after the death of my beloved
 wife Rachael Bonnett all the remainder of my property both
 movable & immovable to be equally divided between them
 named four sons, And I do hereby constitute my sons Wm Bonnett
 Thos Bonnett & my wife executors of this my last will and
 testament & do hereby utterly disallow revoke & annul all and
 every other former testament will & legacy & executors by me
 in any wise before named with the greatest confirming this
 to be my last will & testament & no other, in witness whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 25th day of July
 in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred & the sixty two
