 Give the name of God Amen, William Castliberry being weak in body but
 in my presence & understanding do make this my last will & testament
 &c. I give & bequeath to my loving wife Lucretia Castliberry all my
 estate real & personal without any reserve whatsoever to have & hold during
 her life of widowhood but if she marries she shall inherit none of the aforesaid
 estate but shall be equally divided among between myself & youngest children
 But if the then husband should die before me the property
 shall unto those children their proportionable parts in money they
 may keep the property but if not the executors of this my last will &
 testament shall take the property to be applied to the most useful
 purpose of those children required in witness where up set my hand
 & seal this fifteenth of November in the year of our Lord eighteen
 hundred twelve, signed sealed & acknowledged in presence of
 Odiean Castliberry William Castliberry Esq.
 Elijah Robey Lucretia Castliberry Esq.
 Mark Castliberry Wm.

Georgia Before me personally came Odiean Castliberry
 Jackson County I made oath & saith that he saw the witness
 named William Castliberry sign & deliver the witness will for the
 witness purpose mentioned that he was a subscriber witness
 with Elijah Robey & Mark Castliberry to the due attencion of the
 same sworn to this 12th day of May 1813

 Jackson County being duly sworn saith he saw William
 Castliberry sign the witness will & that this defendant witnessed the
 same in the presence of Odiean Castliberry the said William was
 of sound mind at the time of his subscribing his name to the
 same, sworn to in open court
