

Georgia Jackson County ³ William Curoton being in a low condition of body but of perfect mind & memory do make this my last will & testament hereby revoking all other will or wills by me heretofore made 1st My Will is that all of my just debts be paid out of my estate by my executor & executor to be by me hereafter appointed ~~appointed~~

I give to my grandson Taylor to have one bed & furniture & two mares one a bay with a blaze in her face, the other a bay & one cow & calf & one ewe & Lamb, eight head of hogs now in his own marsh

I give to my well beloved wife Martha one Negro Woman Lett & one negro boy Mingo, & one cow & calf & two hickory & one bed & furniture & all my household & kitchen furniture & the negro which was or coming to me in right of my wife Martha out of the estate of her brother William Baugh late of the State of Virginia deceased & all the balance of my flock of sheep to her & her heirs forever together with all my stock of hogs all of which property to be at the disposition of her my wife Martha at or before her death either by will or otherwise Lastly I do hereby appoint my wife Martha my executor & Hugh Montgomery my sole executor of this my last will & testament Witness my hand & seal this 11th day of May 1810
