perfect sense & of sound disposing mind & memory & knowing the nature
-ty of these presents thought proper to make my will & dispose of the property
I have pleased God to bestow on me with which I give devise & dispose of
Manner & form following (viz)

Item 1st I give & bequeath to my Daughter Linda Haynes the whole she
Hundred charged with in a Book of accounts which I keep against
my children amounting to four hundred & fifty Dollars in Money &
a bed & furniture at forty Dollars to her & her heirs & assigns forever

Item 2nd I give & bequeath to my Daughter Persa Morgan the whole she
Hundred charged with in said Book of accounts amounting to four hundred
& fifty Dollars in Money & a bed & furniture at forty Dollars to her &
her heirs & assigns forever

Item 3rd I give & bequeath to my Daughter Milly Bottom the whole she
Hundred charged with in said Book of accounts amounting to four hundred &
fifty Dollars in Money & a bed & furniture at forty Dollars & I direct
my Executors to pay to her fifty Dollars more than of the rest of my
Daughters as she shall longer with us & consequently some more for
us than any of the rest of my Daughters to her & her heirs & assigns
for ever her

Item 4th I give & bequeath to my Daughter Sally Bottom the whole she
Hundred charged with in said Book of accounts amounting to four hundred
& fifty Dollars in Money & a bed & furniture at forty Dollars & I direct
my Executors to give her also three hundred Dollars I give her in part the price
of my negro Woman which is to be deducted out of her propor-
-tional part of my Estate to her & her heirs & assigns forever

Item 5th I give & bequeath to my Daughter Caroline Pitts the whole she
Hundred charged with in said Book of accounts amounting to four
hundred & fifty Dollars in Money & a bed & furniture at forty Dollars
& a diamond watch to her & her heirs & assigns forever

Item 6th I give & bequeath to my Son John the whole he stand charged with
said Book of accounts amounting to three hundred & Eight Dollars
& give him the further sum of one hundred & twenty two Dollars
which is the first distribution share there of I also give him my
share County land (222) one lot of land drawn & granted by James Hays
& also an other lot of land granted & drawn by Thomas D. Berry to him
& his heirs & assigns forever

Item 7th I give & bequeath to my son John & his heirs at the following tract of land
of land (222) beginning at a Dogwood corner near the City field on the
River thence running on the original line of the Johnson tract of
land to where it crosses the Jones Branch the second time thence up the
Branch to the head thereof from thence a direct line to a survey point on

old field from thence a direct line to a corner on the Reedy
Branch the fourth corner being one of the original corners of the Johnson
tract of land thence down the Reedy Branch to the creek thence down the
creek to a junction corner of the land I bought of Collins thence on the
Collins line to a survey corner on the M^{rs} Gless line thence on the M^{rs}
Gless line to a stake corner between Haynes & Jackson thence along the
original line joining Jackson to a white oak corner near the Jones
old spring this line running through the middle of dipping thence along
the original line through the Swamp to white oak corner thence
along the original line to a sugar tree corner on the bank of the River
thence up the River to the Beginning Dogwood corner & further from my
smooth bore Rifle shot gun to him & his heirs & assigns forever

Item 8th I give & bequeath to my son William M. Gathright all the Ballam of
my land lying here in this County embracing my dwelling house and
plantation & not sold to my son John & Gathright & his heirs & assigns
thence to the full & free possession of the same by my wife Milly during
her life term & further give him all my plantation land & timber &
my Rifle gun to him & his heirs & assigns forever

Item 9th I give & bequeath to my wife Milly the whole of my stock of
Cattle Hogs & Sheep or so much thereof that I am indebted sized of
they being now in the care & possession of my son William & also
give her all my house hold & kitchen furniture of every kind
& description whatever & for her to dispose of the same in any way
or manner she may think proper I also give her the use of my
Mare & Buggy but at her death my Executors will sell the Mare
& Buggy

Item 10th I direct my Executors to collect from my sons John &
Gathright & William M. Gathright the sum of one hundred Dollars
a piece & I may charge them one hundred Dollars each of them
to be paid to my Executors in installments of three years if
they require such indulgence & as there will be considerable
102 money when paying of the said sums as directed in my will
