 appoint my wife my Executrix and Allen
 Langfords my Executor of this my last
 will and Testament

Item 1st I leave and bequeath that my Executrix
 and Executor shall sell such of my Stock as
 my wife can best spare to pay my just
 debts If they find it necessary to sell anything
 Item 2nd I leave and bequeath that my wife
 shall have all my property after paying
 my debts to support a poor during her
 natural life

Item 3rd I leave and bequeath that all my
 property that may remain after the death of
 my wife shall be equally divided between
 my step son Allen Langfords and my own
 children Elizabeth Langfords Sarah Jane
 Langfords Wilson Langfords Mills J.
 Langfords and Catherine L. Langfords
 two thirds my in the second line of Item
 1st was interlined before signing
 In testimony whereof I have hereunto set
 my hand and affixed my Seal this 28th
 day of December 1848
