with the exception of two hundred fifty acres of land wherein
I now live which is to remain in the possession of John Reynolds
my wife for her support during her life after her death to be
equally divided between the above mentioned heirs

2^d That sixty dollars shall be taken out of the sale of the first
house lot & left on interest to Maria Amanda Caroline Reynolds
daughter of Francis Reynolds however of age shall receive the
said amount with all the profits arising from said account
and in case the said child should die before it be of age
the amount shall be equally divided between the above mentioned
heirs. 3rd I hereby constitute & appoint John Reynolds & William
Patterson executors to this my last will & testament.
