I William Stott the County of Jackson & State of Georgia do ordain & appoint this my last will & Testament hereby Revoking all other Legally whatsoever In any Manner or form following that is on this the twenty second Day of August in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight Hundred & forty two to which I have hereunto set my hand & first my Seal binding my say and assigns forever

I give & bequeath unto my wife Jane Stott During her life time or widowhood for her good and Comfortable Maintenance the following property Viz of my Real Estate the Land & Tenements Wharson I now drive and all my Negroes Viz Christopher Harriet Louisa and Rose and other Unishable Property Suffi-

-cient the Part of My Negroes Viz Sarah Dill Couser George Frank Jack Mary & Baby to be Divided between two of my sons Viz Moses Stott & Enock Stott & my other son George Stott to have one Dollar of the Estate the Division to be so as for Sarah & Enock to share together My second Division to be made in the same manner if either of my sons Viz Moses & Enock were to die I have no Children the Negroes is to belong to the other one if they both

to die Without Children their share are to have three of our say's apiece & the Part of My Negroes to be given to my Brother George Stott
