Item 2nd I Bequeath & Devise that all my just debts be paid without delay by my
Exors, Adors, or assigns as I am committing my business estate
be delay in this Right especially as there is no doubt for delay

Item 3rd I Bequeath that my Beloved Wife Elizabeth Randolph to have both
that I personal property of every kind of mine after payment of
all my just debts to be to my Widow as she thinks best to do to be
to at her Decease during her Natural life, or so long as
to remain on my plantation I have living if she should
Marry again to have equal share with my said wife in
that share of the same Mary the property at her death to be
Equally divided amongst all my Children hereafter born

Item 4th I Bequeath that my Daughter Mary I Gilman one half of and
Equal share in what would be one share of my estate a
Child first & the other half to my son John Brown
Brown the other half that would be considered a third part
of my Estate I put hands John & Randolph my son
James Gilman brother to Mary what share to John
Brown of my Estate & manage it for them as they
think best

Item 5th I Bequeath that my son Eliza W Randolph to have one half
of my property & so more

Item 6th I Bequeath that my said Daughter & son of my son Eliza W
Randolph my said Daughter Mary Martha P and
Grandson Eliza W Randolph to have one share each of
my property & so more
