with the remaining part of my estate upon his paying
to each of my other children the following sum of
money hereinafter stated to wit: to my son James Collins
the sum of fifty dollars, to Eady Wallies wife of Thompson
Wallies One hundred dollars, to John Collins the sum
of one hundred dollars, to Rhoda Wright wife of
Ellis Wright the sum of one hundred & twenty dollars
to Sarah Collins one hundred & twenty dollars, to Henry
Collins one hundred dollars, to Elizabeth Collins the sum
of one hundred & twenty dollars, to Priscilla Collins
the sum of one hundred & twenty dollars to be paid

in ~~some~~ bequested statements beginning with the first herein before
 named, so constitute the said several sums one paid & the reserving to my
 unmarried daughter a comfortable support & home upon said tract of land
 I further give unto my daughter Sarah Collins one feather bed & furniture
 to my daughter Elizabeth one feather bed & furniture, to my daughter
 Rebecca one feather bed & furniture further my will is that she a fortunate
 drawer in the present contemplated State Land Lottery, that it may be
 equally divided amongst all my children herein before named except
 my son Abraham who is not to have any interest therein, I do hereby
 appoint my son Abraham Executor of this my last will Testament
 signed said & acknowledged good published & declared in presence of
 Rufel Jones
