Frederick and her two children - Minney & Taylor together
with four hundred and fifty dollars - which he owed me on a
settlement on the thirtieth of March eighteen hundred and
thirty five -

In the second place I give and bequeath to my four grand
sons Thomas Clement Butt - William Butt John Sumner Butt and
Frederick Butt I give to them and their heirs forever - Joney
a negro fellow Ben a fellow - Malinda a woman - these
negroes I wish hired out annually for five years and at the
expiration of that time I wish them together with the proceeds of them
here to be equally divided between my four above named grand
sons Thomas Clement William - John Sumner and Frederick
Butt If any of either of my four above named grand sons
shall die before he comes to be twenty one years old - then I wish
his legacy to be equally divided between all of the living children
of my daughter Mary Butt deceased -

I likewise give and bequeath to my grandson Edmund James Butt one note of hand with the exception of fifty dollars of
it for six hundred and fifty dollars due the twenty ninth day
of May eighteen hundred and thirty six - and dated the third
of April 1835 - and if Edmund James Butt shall die before he
comes to be twenty one years old - I wish his legacy equally divided
