 day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
 and thirty three. Item 1<sup>st</sup> It is my will that first of all my just  
 debts should be paid. Item 2<sup>d</sup> It is my will that all my  
 property be sold in accordance with the Law, and to be divided  
 into two equal parts, one half to my beloved wife Marnida  
 Montgomery during her widowhood, the other half to belong to  
 my daughter Elizabeth H Montgomery. Item third. If  
 my wife Marnida Montgomery should at any time think proper  
 to marry again it is my will that her (my wife's) half of the  
 property should be secured to my daughter before married, but  
 my wife to have the use of it during her natural life. Item  
 fourth. It is my will that John Logan and James H  
 Montgomery (both of Jasper County & State aforesaid,) be
