 upon which I now live a bay horse called Nelson and
 a saddle named called Sally together with them
 beds & furniture also one trunk - and a saddle
 and bridle -

Item 2 I give and bequeath to my three children John
 Thomas, Harriet Elizabeth and Amicus the follow-
 ing property to wit one square square square
 George Ann Gilly Grant John William Abigail Mary
 Elizabeth & Amicus with the increase of said
 acres from the present date. one lot of land in this
 county known as the Stephens lot, with twenty seven
 acres bought of Mr. No. Kimie. one lot of land in
 and in the County ofroup. I do in Charakce
 together with all the property and effects not pre-
 viously bequeathed to my wife in the above Item -
 it is my will that all the land given to my children
 all the sold as soon as it can be done to advantage
 as soon as the guardians herein appointed shall
 think it for the best together with all other property
 given them except the negroes which I will to be hired
 out annually until my children are marry, or become
 of age and as they arrive at age or marry, to receive
 an equal share of all the negroes and money. It is my
 will that the money arising from the sale of
 the land and other property bequeathed to the child-
 ren be kept out at interest until it is delivered

out to them at the times above named.
 Item 3rd I hereby appoint my wife Annella
 my executor to this my will and
 guardians of the persons and property of my chil-
 -dren to manage it as above mentioned -
 Item 4th It is my will that all my just debts be paid
 out of the present crop if sufficient if not sufficient
 for that purpose the balance to be paid out of debts
 due me -
