memory, and calling to mind that it is allotted
for all mankind once to die - Do make and
ordain this my last Will and testament
Item first. I will my soul to God who first gave
it me - Item 2^d I will my body to be buried
in a decent and christian like manner and
all my lawful debts paid - Item 3^d I will
that my Father Frederick Brazill be appointed
and he is hereby appointed guardian for my
son Correl Robinson (now a minor) - Item 4th
I will that all my part of the property now
in my possession and all that belongs to me
as soon as a division can be made, be sold
and put into the hands of the said Frederick
Brazill guardian for the aforesaid Correll
Robinson to be laid out entirely for his
own use or for his education or raising
as his guardian may see fit - Item 5th
I will that if the draw in the present
land lottery put in by me should draw

for all mankind once to die I Do make and
bequeath this my last Will and testament
Item 1st I will my soul to God who first gave
it me - Item 2^d I will my body to be buried
in a decent and christian like manner and
all my lawful debts paid - Item 3^d I will
that my Father Frederick Brazill be appointed
and he is hereby appointed guardian for my
son Terrel (Robinson now a minor) - Item 4th
I will that all my part of the property now
in my possession and all that belongs to me

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and put into the hands of the said Frederick
Brazill guardian for the aforesaid Terrel
Robinson to be laid out entirely for his
own use or for his education or raising
as his guardian may see fit - Item 5th
I will that if the draw in the present
land lottery put in by me should draw
a prize that it remain in the possession of the
guardian for the entire use of the aforesaid
Terrel when he shall come of age and
then be at his entire disposal - Item 6th
I will that the above items as they are
written, be construed in that way that may

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not conduce to the interest of the aforesaid ^{deceased} ~~deceased~~
and that a liberal construction be ^{made} ~~made~~ on the
same, signed, sealed and acknowledged this 17th of

mark.
