the watch remain in the possession of my sister
Mary untill said Melledge B Roby shall have
arrived at the age of twenty One years or gets
married

4th I do hereby give and bequeath unto my beloved
Stephen Melledge B Roby all the remaining
part of my Estate both real and personal
Should he die without legal issue and before
he arrives at the age of twenty One years old
then that part of my Estate which he stands
under this Clause shall be divided as follows
One fourth part of to my sister Mary E Bartlett
for ever my sister Sarah A Bartlett two hundred
Dollars during her Lifetime the balance to be

equally divided between my Brother ~~the balance~~
and sisters except Sarah A Bartlett she having
been provided for as fully as I can with my
wish and my Mother Mary Bartlett Shan and
Shan alike she should any one of my brothers or
sisters die without legal issue and before they arrive
at the age of twenty One years It is my will and
desire that my sister Mary E Bartlett receive a full
distribution share of that part of their Estate which
they may inherit under the provision of this my will
Should further Should my Mother die it is my will and
design that my sister Mary E Bartlett receive a full
distribution share of that part of her Estate which she
may have under the provisions of this my will.

Abner Bartlett my Executor and my brother James C
Bartlett my Executor to carry into effect this my
