 that then be disposed of in the manner and form
 following to wit. It is my will and desire after
 my death that my Estate be equally divided amongst
 my children - nam Lawfull heirs alive except my
 Daughter Mary & Wives and it is my will that all
 that will be due to her or her representative - after
 my death should go to her children. the heirs of
 her body. and that it should be kept in the hands
 of my Lawfull Executors for their benefit alone -
 and I do hereby nominate and appoint Phillip B.
 Bitchett. Isaac Randall and William C. Farley
 Executors of this my last will and Testament - and
 revoking all other heretofore made or to be
 made by me - In testimony whereof I have hereunto
 set my hand and affixed my Seal this 21st Month
 1838 -
