hundred Dollars out of the Sale of the land in the place
of a horse bridle Saddle which was left him in my
husband will I also have him one feather bedstead
of furniture if he should die before he gets twenty one
years of age the bed bedstead of furniture to be divided betw
een my then youngest daughters & the hundred Dollars to
be equally divided between my other five youngest Chil-
dren the balance of the Sale of the land to be equally
divided between my six youngest Children 4th I have
my daughter Harriette one bay Horse Collar & side
Saddle 5th I have my son Shadrach G Thompson a gray
filly and Saddle 6th I have my son Chasly Thompson
one barrel horse and one Cow & calf I also with all my
my Children break up house keeping for my son
Shadrach G & Chasly Thompson to have all my farming
tools & Cart & yoke of Sticks if within of them dies before
they become twenty one years old I want the other
to have all I have them both. 7th I have all my home
hold furniture to my then youngest Daughter with the
Exception of the bed furniture left to my son Vinson
to be equally divided between them. the gray filly &
Saddle left to my son Shadrach G Thompson for the use of his own bridle Saddle

2nd left him in my husband will also the horse & Cow &
 Calf left Chesley Thompson is for the horse bridle Saddle
 left in said Will 8th I leave One Cow two yearling
 to my six youngest Children for their own use
 9th I leave my daughter Nancy Thrown five Dollars
 to be paid ~~out of~~ the sale of my land when sold
 10th I leave my Daughter Mary McRay five Dollars
