

Georgia. In the name of God Amen.

I, William Wagoner of the County of Jasper State aforesaid being possessed of my sound disposing mind and memory and knowing it is appointed for all men once to die, do make, constitute ordain & appoint this my last will and testament in the following words, When I shall bequeath my soul into the hands of God, who gave it me, my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent and Christian like manner, and all my lawful debts paid —

1st As to the worldly goods with which the Lord has blessed me, I will to my beloved Mother Mary Cannon all my estate real and personal, lands, goods and chattels for and during her natural lifetime, to be used at her discretion in any way she may think proper at the death of my beloved Mother, I will for Beloved Brother in law James W. Foster & Eleazer Foster my sister to have all of my estate that may then be left particularly my land that I own both in this and Baker County and for their offspring to enjoy it after them —

Item 2^d I will that my Executors pay out of my estate to my beloved Sister Eady Walker, as they may see proper and fit each year, till they pay her one hundred and fifty dollars; but she is not entitled to receive any part of my estate, either real or personal except as before stated provided she does not live with Asa Walker. If she does not I wish for her not to have any part of my estate, nor for my executors to pay any money on any account out of the same.

Item 3^d I will that my beloved mother Mary Cannon and James W. Foster, he and they are hereby appointed executors to this my last will and testament, and that they have discretionary power to manage all or any part of my estate as they may think best —
