Return of the Commissioners
Georgia By Virtue of an order
Gasper County Per from the honorable
Superior Court of said County when
sitting for ordinary purposes - on the
first Monday in November 1837. To me
directed, authorizing and requiring us
to make distribution of the Estate of
the late Jacob McDaniel dec'd - among the
Distributors of said Estate; we proceed on
this day to the performance of said duty
- we ascertained there were three distributees
(to wit) Thys J Toland, the Survivors of Mary
Ann McDaniel, and Robert Brown Guardian
of George F. McDaniel, and Martha Ann McDaniel - Minor Children of said deceased
- The shares were numbered 1, 2, 3, and assigned to the distributees in the following
manner, (to wit) The names of the Distributees
were written on a piece of paper and placed
in a hat. The numbers were written on
other pieces of paper, and put in another
hat. The hats were both well shaken, a name
was then drawn from the hat containing
the names; then a number was drawn from
the hat containing the numbers. The following
