I James Harral of said County being of sound mind and memory, and knowing the mortality of my body, and knowing it is appointed for all men once to die, do make Constitute and ordain this to be my last will and testament First of all I give my soul to Almighty God that gave it. and my body to the Earth to be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my friends and Executors, not doubting but I shall receive the same again and as to my worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this world, I give and dispose in the following manner (to wit) Item the 1st I give and bequeath unto my son Isaac Harral, one negro man by the name of Ned. I also give my daughter Elizabeth Mach one negro boy named Bob, I also give my daughter Sarah Jones one negro girl named Eliza I also give my daughter Lydia Webb one negro woman named Dick. I also give my two grandsons Eli and James Webb one negro girl named Luke and after it is my will that all of my Estate both real and personal to be equally divided between my Children, I also constitute and appoint my son Isaac Harral and Johnbargile Sen. my Executors to this my last will & testament - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 6th day of August 1822
