Account of sale of one lot of Land sold in the Term
of Michaelmas on Tuesday the 26th day of October 1814
the same belonging to James Pinson dec. formerly
Randolph County now Jasper County the same
was sold in obedience to an order of the hono-
rable Superior Court of said County at September
Term one thousand eight hundred and thirteen
after being duly gazetted as the law directs at
which time Lewis Duquesne became the purchaser
at public outcry and the said land was
sold for three hundred dollars in two different
payments one half the 26th of October 1814
the other half twelve months thereafter, the
said Land was sold at the request of Henry
Koon one of the lawfull heirs of the above
dec. in his petition have been shown to said Court
and granted by their honors
