Constitute and appointing this my last will
and Testament revoking all other wills
or gifts by me heretofore made or directed
to be made. Right

I want give to my son Henry Capels the
two ~~half~~ half a lot of Land lying
on the water of Little River in the
Nineteenth District of Baldwin where

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My wife Mary Capels one
Negro boy named Thomas
Give to my son Solomon Capels one
Negro girl by the name of Jude thirdly
I give to my daughter Mary Jones one
Negro girl by the name of Nancy fourthly
I give to my daughter Rebecca Burdette
Negro boy by the name of Lewis. I give
to my son Jerry Capels one bed and garni-
ture. Fifthly I give to my daughter
Elizabeth Burdette one Negro woman
named Hannah after the death of her
Master. Lastly to my wife I give
her life time one Negro Woman by
the name of Hannah also one
bed and furniture and one cow and

Witness my hand and seal this 1st day of
April 1815

That I have by my Personal Estate
be equally divided amongst my
children this will to be paid
twelve months after my death and
the heirs can agree amongst themselves
Equally to be their parts.

I have by appointing two or more
Attorneys and being the Executors
of this my last will. Signed
