Moor, part or division of the real and personal estate of the aforesaid William Askew deceased, and therefore I the said William H. Moor as trustee for the aforesaid Mary D. Moor do by these presents release acquit and forever discharge the aforesaid Thomas Key, his heirs, executors, and Administrators, of and from the said shares dividends of the estate aforesaid, and of and from all actions, suits, payments, accounts, reckonings, claims and demands whatsoever, for or by reason thereof, or any other act, matter, cause, or of any thing whatsoever from beginning of the world to the day of the present date.

I, John Newby of the County of Jasper State of Georgia being sick of body, but of sound mind & memory, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament in manner & form following - To wit -
I give and bequeath to my four eldest children To wit - my daughter Nancy R. Crawford the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars - I give and bequeath to my daughter Irene Leaps the like sum of one hundred and fifty dollars - I give and bequeath to my daughter Matilda Green the like sum of one hundred & fifty dollars - And I also give and bequeath the like sum of one hundred & fifty dollars to my sonarkin C. Newby - I also give and bequeath to my four above named Children one tract of land lying in the seventh district & second section in Cherokee County and known as lot Number forty nine -

All the rest and residue of my estate goods & chattels I give and bequeath to my four youngest children, in manner & mode hereinafter pointed out - It is my will that all my estate both real and personal remaining after paying the legacies bequeathed to my four eldest children above named shall remain in the possession of my beloved wife Jane Newby, for the support & maintenance of my four youngest children - Notwithstanding if either of them becomes of age or intermarries - Then and in that case, each one shall be entitled to an equal share of the property already bequeathed - It is my will that if my beloved wife should marry, that then my Executors herein after named should proceed immediately to transfer to divide the estate bequeathed to my four youngest children into five equal parts, giving one fifth to my beloved wife in lieu of dower - And it is also my will that the remaining four fifths of the

Of the estate should be taken possession of by my Executor and managed exclusively by him for the exclusive benefit of my four youngest children - And it is further my Will that my Executor gives off to each of my four youngest children as they become of age or marry, one fourth of the estate already bequeathed -

I do nominate, constitute and appoint James Adams my sole Executor of this my last will and testament - In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal. This 27th day of July 1836 -
