of Jasper and State of ^{Georgia} being of sound mind and disposing
memory knowing the uncertainty of life and that it is appointed
for all men once to die do constitute and ordain this my last
will and testament in manner and form following (witness)
I leave my soul to the great god that first gave it and my
body at the discretion of my Executors to be buried in a
Christian like manner and after all my just debts is
paid. I give my two negro girls Fanner & Peg to Rebecca
Dickson children of heirs of John Dickson dec.) their heirs
and assigns forever. Item I give my negro boy Tom my
House, my Kitchen furniture and plantation tools to
Samuel Smith (son of Griffin) his heirs and assigns
for ever. Item I give to the heirs of Asa Roggett fifteen
hundred dollars where it is collected out of two notes
of hand given by David Cannon and made payable
to me one of the notes was given for twelve hundred
dollars, which note is now filed in the Clerk's office
of the Inferior Court of Jones County and the other note
for three hundred dollars is now among my papers
Item I give to my three negroes all my cloath and other
burial expences. I give the balance of my estate to
Reuben Smith his heirs and assigns forever, and I
do hereby revoke and make void all and every other
will or wills made by me heretofore and I do consti-
tute and appoint Reuben Smith Asa Roggett &
Richard Hughbanks my Executors to this my last will
and testament & Confirming the same. In witness
my hand I have hereunto set my hand and affixed

for all men once to die do constitute and ordain this my last
will and testament in manner and form following (vizt)
I leave my soul to the great god that first gave it and my
body at the discretion of my Executors to be buried in a
Christian like manner and after all my just debts is
paid. I give my two negro Gals Hammer & Peg to Rebecca
Dicksons (children of heirs of John Dickson dec.) their heirs

for ever. Item I give to the heirs of Asa Duggett fifteen

to me one of the notes was given for twelve hundred
dollars, which note is now filed in the clerk's office
of the Superior Court of Jones County and the other note
for three hundred dollars is now among my papers
Item I give to my three negroes all my cloath and after
burial expences. I give the balance of my estate to
Abner Smith his heirs and assigns forever, and I
do hereby revoke and make void all and every other
will or wills made by me heretofore and I do consti-
tute and appoint Abner Smith Asa Duggett &
Richard Houghbanks my Executors to this my last will
and Testament & Confirming the same. In witness
my whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my seal this twenty seventh day of January
in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
