and from the creek to the back line of said tract of
land, and the half of said tract joining of Thomas P.
Hamilton he is to have at my decease, and at the
decease of my daughter Delany Hickson, without
any bond the whole of the premises is to return to

thru the fields from Pleasant Patter to the creek,
and from the creek to the back line of said tract of
land, and the half of said tract joining of Thomas P.
Hamilton he is to have at my decease, and at the
decease of my daughter Delany Hickson, without
an heir the whole of the property is to return to
Robert W. Daniel and his heirs forever.
