

Continuation of the Probate

January 23rd 1816 Elizabeth Byers appeared
for Letters of administration on the estate of
Lawrence Byers deceased and Letters
issued accordingly.

March 1st 1816 Letters of administration
on the estate of Lawrence Byers was granted
to Elizabeth Byers who was sworn in for
Court and gave Eliza Mundy for security in
the sum of one thousand dollars a money
bond 1816 of said Court the following
order was made.

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Elizabeth Byers
administration on the estate of Lawrence
Byers deceased for leave to remove her
proceedings on said estate.

Ordered that the said administration
be permitted to remove her administration
to the County of Jasper and procuring for
that Court a full accomplishment of
the whole proceedings had on said estate
and complying with the Law in such cases
made and provided. To certify that the
 foregoing is a true accomplishment of
the whole proceedings had on the estate
of Lawrence Byers in that County
(Morgan) as appears from the records
