

Ordinary Office Jasper County 1836

I Lucy Tinsley being weak in body but sound of mind & memory do make and constitute this my last Will, and Testament (To wit)

Item 1. My will is that all my just debts be paid.

2. My will is that the following named negroes, Mary, George, Jack and Hannah be held out until my son Charles Tinsley shall come of age and the proceeds be equally divided between my children.

3. My will is that negroes Joe and Sally and all my household furniture together with all my other personal property be sold and equally divided between my heirs.

4. My will is that my land in Columbia County that it be sold by him at his discretion, & the proceeds equally divided between my heirs.

5. I ordain & appoint my trusty friend Peter Crumfords my Executor.

Witness I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this 30 day of May 1835 - Signed sealed & delivered in presence of us

Personally came into open Court Alexander Hawthorn, one of the subscribing Witnesses to the within Will, who being duly sworn depose and swear that he saw Lucy Tinsley, sign seal, publish & declare this to be her last will & Testament & at P^m then she was of sound

Now 1. My will is that all my just debts be paid.

2^d My will is that the following named negroes, Maby, George, Jack and Hannah be retained until my son Charles Tinsley shall come of age and the proceeds be equally divided between my children.

3^d My will is that negroes, he and Sally and all my household furniture together with all my other personal property be sold and equally divided between my heirs.

4th My will is that if Peter Crawford has not sold my land in Calumnia County that it be sold by him at his discretion, & the proceeds equally divided between my heirs.

5th I ordain I appoint my trusty friend Peter Crawford my Executor.
