In the name of God amen! I Mary G. Cox of
the County of Jasper and State of Georgia, being of
infirm health but of sound mind and memory
do make this my last will and Testament, in
manner following Viz-

Item 1st I give and bequeath unto my brother
Meddleton W. Cox, my three negroes, Charles, Hannah
and Huldah.

Item 2^d I give and bequeath unto my sister Sarah G. Cox
my two negroes Jefferson and Henry -

Item 3^d I give and bequeath unto my brother Meddleton
W. Cox and my sister Sarah G. Cox all of my interest
in my mother's estate, whether land, money or negroes, &
also all my interest in my Father's estate -

Item 4th I give and bequeath to my brother Meddleton W.
Cox and my sister Sarah G. Cox all the money which
may be coming to me for the hire of my negroes (except
the money which may have arisen from the hire of Henry
and Perna) the money to be equally divided between them.

Item 5th I give and bequeath to my sister Sarah G. Cox
all of my wearing apparel of every description -

Item 6th I give and bequeath to my brother Meddleton W.
Cox and my sister Sarah G. Cox, all my beds, bedsteads
and bed clothing, to be equally divided between them.

Item 7th I give and bequeath to my brother in law, Squardman
John Briggs, my two negroes, Jerry and Perna - And
do not wish them to be separated it is my will & desire
that he should have Jerry and Perna and that they should
be kept together - I also will and bequeath unto my said
brother in law and guardian John Briggs, all the money
that has arisen from the hire of said negroes Jerry & Perna -

Item 8th I will and bequeath all my estate of every
other description, both real and personal, which I now
own or may in any of the foregoing items to my brother Meddleton
W. Cox and my sister Sarah G. Cox, to be equally
divided between them -
