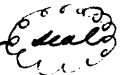


1834 Georgia In the name of God Amen I Nancy M^c Fall
 Jasper County being weak in body but of sound mind and memory
 do make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner and
 form following Viz^t
 First I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth M^c Fall one bay
 horse three years old and fifty dollars in money, of that money due
 me in South Carolina and one third part of my cattle except the two
 steers. Secondly I give and bequeath to my son Fleming M^c Fall
 and two daughters Sonney Smith and Jane Bailey all the money
 I have or that is due me not before mentioned to be equally divided
 between them. I also give to said Fleming M^c Fall two steers and
 one third part of my cattle, and also give to my said daughter Jane
 Bailey the other third part of my cattle. Also I give to my said son
 Fleming M^c Fall my waggon and gear, and I further give my beds
 and bed clothes to my daughter Elizabeth M^c Fall and Jane Bailey
 also I give to said Elizabeth all my household and kitchen furniture
 those of my children not mentioned in this my last will I have
 given them their portion of property heretofore. I hereby make my
 son Fleming M^c Fall sole executor of this my last will and
 testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 seal this 25th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and thirty one Signed sealed and declared in
