his wisdom B. Otto Tharmong Apppling of the County
of Jasper and aforeaid State, being in perfect tranquility
and soundness of mind, though in a declining
state of health, not knowing how soon or suddenly
I may be called hence to make, constitute and ordain
this to be my last Will and testament. — And
first of all I commit my soul into the hands of
my most merciful father, the great architect of
the Universe hoping for salvation through the merits
of my Saviour Jesus Christ. and my body to its
Mother Earth to be buried in a decent and
Christian manner at the discretion of my friends
John Brown, John B. Golding, William Apppling
and my beloved Wife Jane M. Apppling, whom
I appoint my executors and Executors to This my last
will and testament. — And as to my worldly
Estate which it has pleased God to bless me with
I dispose of as follows to wit —
Item first. I wish my property managed by my
Executors and Executors in such manner as they
may deem most conducive to the best interest
of my family) in discharging all my lawful
debts ~~and~~ the residue of my property both real
and personal I wish kept together untill my
daughter Connehei Ann arrives at lawful age
or marry) then and in that case I wish
my estate to be equally divided among them
share and share alike (meaning my wife
and children) but in case my Wife should
marry previous to that time, it is my wish

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She should have a child's part taken from my estate
and the balance kept together for my children as
written above — And I do revoke all other wills
heretofore made by me.
