

In the name of God amen, I
Reuben Jones Sen, of the County and
State of Indiana being of full age and sound
mind and disposing mind and memory do hereby make
and declare this my last will and testament
in manner and form following to wit:
1st After paying all of my just debts which I wish
come from the proceeds of the sale of my store of Cattle
to go. horses, corn, household and kitchen furniture
&c. &c. It is my wish that the balance of my property be
divided between my children and grand children
in the following manner. viz: I give and bequeath to
Reuben Jones Jun a negro man named Will, and one
lot of land situate lying and being in the 18th District of
Pe County, Brown and distinguished as No 387 (two hundred and
thirty seven), in L. District, but he the said Reuben
Jones Jun shall pay to my Daughter Patsy New for the
use of herself and children the sum of Fifty dollars to be
equally divided between them - share and share alike -
and I give and bequeath to my grandson Efford W. Jones
a negro woman named Vinny - but he the said Efford W.
shall pay to my Daughter Patsy New, the sum of Fifty
dollars, and to his sister Mary H. his brother Elijah H.
his sister Harriett L. and his brother Reuben L. each Fifty
dollars as they arrive at the age of twenty one years, the
above gift shall not be valid until the said Efford W.
Jones complies with my wish as above named and expressed.
3rd Believing as I do that the rest of my children, viz
Marshall, Elijah and John W. Jones have each received
a full share of my estate, I do hereby give to the heirs of
each of them the sum of one hundred dollar as a token of
remembrance.
4th It is my Will and desire further that if there
should be any surplus property or money remaining after
complying with the bequests herein before expressed that
the said surplus if any shall belong and be given to my son

1st I do hereby and am appoint my son Reuben Jones
Jun my Executor to carry into effect this my last will
and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto

October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and thirty five.
