 has been pleased to bless me - I dispose of in the following
 manner viz -

first of all I give to my wife Elizabeth M^r Glendon all
 my property during her life time or widowhood for her to
 have discretionary power to give to each of our children an
 equal part except my son W^m Washington M^r Glendon I give
 the plantation on which I live to him after his mother's death
 and Blount Garrett children William and Elizabeth I
 give an equal part after their fathers mother death =
 I leave my wife and Jacob M^r Glendon my Executors =
 And in testimony whereof I have set my hand and
 affixed my seal - this twenty third day of February in the
 year of our Lord 1834 -
