1st I give unto my beloved wife Lucy the Land and plantation with the House and kitchen furniture plantation tools, stock of horses, cattle hogs and sheep and all my negro slaves during her life for her said Lucys support and the board of my two daughters Elizabeth and Henry so long as they live single and at the death of my wife Lucy I give unto my son Wiley one negro boy Robin, I give unto my son Henry one negro girl Harriet, I give unto my son John one negro man Nathan, I give unto my son William one negro boy Sam, I give unto my daughter Jane, one negro girl May, I give unto my daughter Lucy, one negro girl Abiley, I give unto my daughter Mary one negro girl Luce I give unto my daughter Candis one negro boy Hansel I give unto my daughter Elizabeth one negro girl Minney, I give unto my daughter Mary one negro girl Easter, I give unto my daughter Nancy one negro girl Bess and her youngest child Nanner my Will further is that at my wifes death she dispose of one negro boy Jim at her pleasure and at the death of my wife I give unto my son William two Lots of land Numbers sixty nine (69) and seventy (70) I give unto my son John the whole balance of my lands my Will further is that all cash in hand, book accounts and present crops, be and remain in the hands of my Wife for her support she paying of my just debts and at her death all my property not otherwise disposed of, be sold and equally divided between all my children to Wiley, Henry, John, William, Jane, Lucy, Mary, Nancy, Candis Elizabeth & Henry; lastly I constitute and appoint my two sons Wiley, Dean & William Dean my Executors to this my last Will requiring them to act in that way that may be most to the advancement of my Estate, In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal, this twenty seventh day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty - Signed sealed in presence of.
