Georgia and County of Jasper being
in health of body and mind but
calling to remembrance that it
is appointed once for all men
to die to make and ordain this
my last will and testament
in the manner and form following
hereby revoke all other.

Jasper County Estates, Appraisements, Inventories, Wills, Annual Returns,
1815 to 1820
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First of all I give my soul to God
who gave it and my body to be
buried in a Christian like manner
at the discretion of my executor
nothing doubting but that it will
be raised at the resurrection. I
as to the property where with I
pleased God to bless me with I
dispose of in the following man-
ner. I do not intend to give my
beloved wife Abigail Ellofett in
case she should survive me any
negro woman named Patt and
one bed and furniture during
her natural life or widowhood
and that she be maintained
by my three sons James John
and Thos Ellofett.

and that she have her choice to live with which of my sons she chooses
Item 2nd I give and bequeath unto my son James H. Moffatt all that lot of land number one Hundred and thirty nine on the thirteenth district formerly Baldwin now Jasper county which lies south west of a line which runs as follows

beginning at a black oak corner on Jasper County Estates, Appraisements, Inventories, Wills, Annual Returns, 1815 to 1820.
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between said lot and lot number one Hundred and forty running a marked line to a black oak then to a Hickory thence to a white oak near the head of a branch thence down the meander of a branch to where it crosses the line between said lot and lot number one Hundred and thirty eight.

Item 3rd I give appraising each unto my son John Moffatt all the balance of my lot of land number one Hundred and thirty nine including the plantation together with all the improvements thereon
Item 4th I give and bequeath unto my son John Moffatt all that tract of land whereon he now lives it being one half lot number one hundred and thirty on the thirteenth district formerly

Believe in now Jasper County together with the improvements thereon. Item 5th It is my desire that after my debts are paid that the balance of my estate not already given away should be equally divided among all my children, to wit: James Jackson, Henry Hunter, Betty Boy, Thomas Elffatt and Nathan Elffatt and after the death of my wife Abigail Elffatt share of my estate which was left to her to be equally divided among all my children aforesaid. I do constitute and appoint my son James Elffatt and my son in law Nathan Jackson my Executors to execute this my last will and testament in which of them will set my hand and seal this 10th day of October in the year of our Lord
