

Georgia In the name of God Amen
 Jasper County I Wiley Holifield of the County
 and State aforesaid being much
 afflicted in Body and of declining health, but of sound
 mind, and knowing that it is appointed for all men
 once to die do hereby bequeath and distribute my
 estate as follows to wit,
 Item. 1.st I give and bequeath unto my eldest son
 Daniel S. Holifield, my negro woman Moll
 & the increase of her body after my decease.
 Item. 2.nd I give and bequeath unto my second son
 John Holifield my negro Boy Arch.
 Item 3.rd I give and bequeath unto my third son Andr-
 ew. J. Holifield my negro Boy Gene.
 Item 4.th I give and bequeath unto my fourth son
 Thomas Holifield, my negro girl Martha
 and her increase after my decease.
 Item 5.th I give and bequeath unto my youngest son
 Christopher Holifield my negro girl Beccat.
 her increase after my decease.
 Item. 6.th If it should so happen that any of the a-
 bove Negroes. should as bequeathed should die
 before the time to which it is bequeathed shall
 arrive at mature age. or come into possession
 thereof. It is my will that another of equal
 value. be put in its place out of my unque-
 athed estate.
 Item 7.th As I am desirous of putting my children
 upon equal footings, and as my son Daniel
 has had a horse bridle and saddle and feather
 Bed. I will that all the rest of my children
 have a Horse bridle and saddle and feather
 bed as they arrive at a proper age to take
 charge to take charge of the same, the same
 to be paid as the same shall be.

Item 8. I will that all my children as they are
at proper ages and commence for themselves
have a cow and calf. sow and pigs and two
hens and Lambs.

Item 9.th It is my will that at my decease my
executors, pay in the first place all my just de-
bts if there should be any against me.

Item. 10.th I will that all the balance of my esta-
te real and personal remain in the possession of
my wife Mary Holifield for her comfort and support
and for the raising supporting and Educating
the Children during her life time or widowhood
and at her death the whole of the effects to be
equally divided among my children. And if
She should intermarry she is to be intitled
to one third part of the estate to dispose of at her
death, or. to one third part her life time
at her decease the whole to revert to my children
(that is to say. to one third part of the unbequeathed
part of my estate).

Item. 11. It is my will that if my unbequeathed
estate should be mismanaged or wasted
the injury of my children that my executors have
no effectually against it.

Item 12 - I constitute and appoint Daniel
S Holifield and Pelcom Parks. my executors
to execute this my last will and Testament.

Lastly. I do hereby publish and declare this to be
my last will and Testament In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 22nd day of May
