2^d I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Polly, 800 dollars and a negro man named Simon, a negro woman named Defa & a negro woman named Lily, two hundred acres of land including the plantation and house where I now live and an equal share of hay, hogs and kitchen furniture. 3^d one seventh part, four cows and calves, and good horn, bridle & saddle to have during her life or widowhood.

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4th I give my beloved son Benjamin Baice Co. 200 dollars and an equal part of the balance of my estate when my youngest child shall become of age -

5th I give my beloved son Benjamin Baice Co. 200 dollars and Thomas Johnson two hundred dollars each

6th I give to my beloved daughter Sarah Johnson twelve hundred dollars.

I give my sons Benjamin Baice Co. David and Thomas Johnson one hundred dollars each out of the balance of my estate for education.

I give my daughter Sarah Johnson one hundred dollars of balance of my estate for schooling.

I give my sister Sarah Tyler her maintenance as long as she may see proper to make my youngest reside in her home.

I give the balance of my estate to be equally divided between my children when the youngest may come at lawful age.

I name and appoint my beloved wife Polly

do hereby make this my last will & testament.
1st My will is that all my just debts be paid at

2^d I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Polly B. 3^d I give to my beloved daughter Malinda Johnson twelve hundred dollars and an equal part of the balance of my estate when my youngest child shall become of age —

4th I give my beloved sons Benjamin Brice Co. Davis and Thomas Johnson twelve hundred dollars each out of the balance of my estate.

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I give my son Benjamin Brice Co. Davis and Thomas Johnson one hundred dollars each out of the balance of my estate for education.

I give my daughter Sarah Johnson one hundred dollars of balance of my estate for schooling.

I give my sister James Tyler her maintenance as long as she may see proper to make my youngest recognize her home.

I give the balance of my estate to be equally divided between my children when the youngest may come at lawful age.

I name and appoint my beloved wife Polly B. Johnson Executrix to this my last will & testament. I also appoint Nicholas Johnson, William Johnson & John Parns executors, & William Grayson —
