

Georgia In the name of God Amen I Williamson Robey of the
Jasper County State and County aforesaid being of sound and disposing mind
and memory, and knowing the certainty of death and the uncertainty of the contin-
uance of life do make ordain and establish this my last will and testament in
manuscript form following viz.

Item 1. I give to my beloved wife Mariah Robey certain tract of land lying and
being in the County aforesaid containing seventy three acres more or less adjoining
the lands of Jacob Finn and Jacob Pope during her natural life I also give and
bequeath to my wife the said Mariah Robey the following negroes, to wit: Sam
a man, Jim a boy, Fanny a girl and Christiana a girl. I amitt a girl and
My Annan during her natural life time I also give and bequeath unto the
said Mariah Robey my wife all the household and kitchen furniture at this
place also a mahogany bedstead and corner cupboards at my other plantation
also all the stock of hogs I have at this place also one horse and saddle worth
eighty or one hundred Dollars also the stock of cattle at this place also one
years provision - Item 2^d. I give and bequeath to my son Milledge Robey
one negro boy named Tony forever also one boy named Clem also Dolly
a girl. Item 3^d. I give and bequeath to my youngest son Williamson
Aquila Marcus W. La Fayette Robey one negro boy named Nelly forever
Item 4th. I give and bequeath to my three grand children William Caroline
and Jane Robey each one hundred Dollars to be paid out of my Estate by my
Executor at his discretion and for any object he may deem proper

Item 5. I give and bequeath to my daughter Eliza Ann Roswell one negro
boy named Henry during her natural life.

Item 6. I give and bequeath to my three grand children, William, John W and
Elizabeth the children of Henry and Eliza Ann Roswell Four hundred dollars
each to be paid by my Executor as they come of age out of my Estate -

Item 7. It is will and desire that the remaining part of my Estate be sold
by my Executor and after paying all my just debts the balance to be divided as
follows to my son Milledge Robey one third to W. A. M. P. L. Robey one

in and to the form following viz.

- Item 1. I give and bequeath to my son Milledge Robey one negro boy named Tony forever also one boy named Clem also Polly a girl. Item 3^d. I give and bequeath to my youngest son Williamson Aquilla Marcus De La Fayette Robey one negro boy named Hellingy forever Item 4th. I give and bequeath to my three grand children William Caroline and Jane Robey each one hundred Dollars to be paid out of my Estate by my Executor at his discretion and for any object he may deem proper Item 5. I give and bequeath to my daughter Eliza Ann Roswell one negro boy named Henry during her natural life. Item 6. I give and bequeath to my three grand children, William, John W and Elizabeth the children of Henry and Eliza Ann Roswell Four hundred dollars each to be paid by my Executor as they come of age out of my Estate - Item 7. It is will and desire that the remaining part of my Estate be sold by my Executor and after paying all my just debts the balance to be divided as follows to my son Milledge Robey one third to W. A. M. P. L. Robey one third and the remaining third to my infant yet unborn, and in case of the death of either of them without issue and before marriage his or her part to be equally divided between the surviving two Item 8. I do hereby declare that my wife Mariah Robey keep the negro boy Hellingy until my youngest son W. A. M. P. L. Robey comes of age and then to be sold by my Executor

Now 18th And further it is my will and desire and wish it to be distinctly understood that at the death of my wife Hannah Roby the property and its increase which I have given to her shall return to and be equally divided between my two sons Milledge Roby and W. A. M. D. Roby and my infant child yet unborn

Lastly I do hereby appoint my son Milledge Roby my Executor to carry this my last will and testament into effect. Witness my hand and seal this the 14th day of April in the year of our Lord 1834.
