Matthews widow & Relic of said Agrella Matthews Jr deceased, James W. Clarke Catherine L. Matthews Trustee of Mary Caroline Olive Catharine L. Matthews Guardian of Lewis D. Matthews, Catherine Matthews & Sarah A. Matthews Trustee for Mary Caroline Olive No. 6 consisted of 119 Acres valued at 525.00 and assigned to James W. Clarke This 13th day of November 1848

 widow Nancy Lovernah and Willey Lovernah children
