orable Court of Ordinary of said County, to one directed
authorizing and requiring us to make distribution of
the estate of Elijah Smith deceased, late of said
County. Among the distribution entitled to said estate
we proceeded this day to the performance of that duty.
There were eleven distributees to wit:

The property was divided into eleven shares that is the negro property numbered 1. 2. 3. 4. 5. 6. 7. 8. 9. 10. 11. which was assigned to the distributees in the following manner to wit -

The names of the distributions were written on separate pieces of paper and placed in a box. The numbers were placed in another box on separate pieces of paper & the boxes were well shaken after the names were placed in the boxes a name was then drawn from the box containing the names and a number was drawn from the box containing the numbers. Order this number contained till all were drawn.

Jefferson County } of ordinary of said county to us
directed to make a distribution of the estate of Rebecca
Cain a minor late of said County deceased the same
being slaves in the hand of Edward H. H. Hunter
the guardian of said deceased among her lawful
distributors Margaret S Cain Jane Cain (wife of
James S Cain) Hamilton & Margaret Cain.

We proceeded in the following manner this day to
execute said order after first being duly sworn
according to law. The distribution of said estate was
found to be four & one half the estate was to
be divided as near as possible into four equal
parts. We then arranged the slaves classifying
them as far as possible into four equal
parts or lots which were designated as follows
