State of Georgia. By virtue of an order from the Jefferson County, Honorable Court of Ordinary of said County on the first Monday in December last, hundred & fifty nine to us directed an hearing and requiring us to make distribution of the Estate of the late William Johnson Mann deceased among the distributees entitled to said Estate we proceeded this day to the performance of that duty. There were three distributees James P. Smith, George E. Smith, Elijah E.
