

Georgia. By virtue of an order from the Jefferson County, Honorable Court of Ordaining of said County dated on the twenty second day of December instant to us directed, authorizing and requiring us to make distribution of the Estate of the late Henry B. Todd deceased among the distributees of the Estate aforesaid, we proceeded on this day to the performance of that duty.
