 ted consisted of Land which we ascertained by survey (by
 J. B. Atkins, C.P. whom we employed to assist us in said
 distribution) to contain two hundred and forty eight (248)
 Acres, exclusive of the endow Dams. we proceeded first to divide
 the land into six (6) Lots as near equal in value as we could
 after having given the legal notice to all the parties interested
 and taken the Oath prescribed by law, we commenced on the
 East part of said land, and laid off Lot No. 1 containing
 thirty three (33) Acres. No. 2 (35) No. 3 (34) No. 4 (44) No. 5 (68 and No. 6
 (38 acres). The shares as above mentioned were assigned to the
 distributees in the following manner, to wit, the names of
 the distributees were written on a piece of paper and placed
 in a hat, the numbers were written on another piece of paper
 and put in another hat, the hats were both well shaken and
 a name was then drawn from the hat containing the names,
 the number was drawn from the hat containing the
 numbers, and in that manner continued till all were drawn.
