to wife, Samuel L. Anderson, Paranah Whitedhead, and James Anderson. Children of said James Anderson deceased of full age and William P. Anderson, Michael Anderson and Rachel Anderson Minn Children of said James Anderson deceased whose interest was represented, in said distribution by John Green Guardian of said Minn Children. The property to be distributed consisted of Land which we ascertained by survey (by J. B. Atkin, C. S. whom we employed to assist us in said distribution) to contain, two hundred and forty eight (248) acres, exclusive of the undivided Dams, we proceeded first to divide the land into six (6) lots as near equal in value as we could after having given the legal notice to all the parties interested and take the Oath prescribed by law, we commenced on the East part of said land, and laid off Lot No. 1 containing thirty acres. No. 2 (35) No. 3 (36) No. 4 (44) No. 5 (68 and No. 6 (33 acres). The shares as above mentioned were assigned to the distributor in the following manner, to wit, the names of the distributees were written on a piece of paper and placed in a hat, the numbers were written on another piece of paper and put in another hat, the hats were held well shaken, a name was then drawn from the hat containing the names, the number was drawn from the hat containing the numbers, and in that manner continued till all were drawn. The following is the result:
