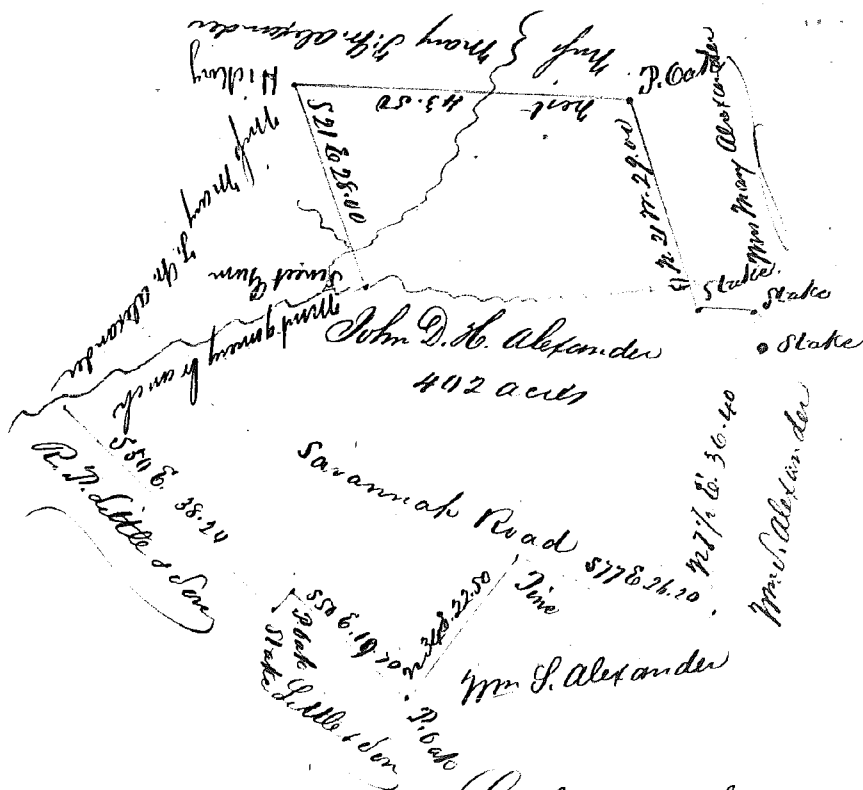


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 Georgia, By virtue of an order from the
 Superior Court of the County of Baldwin (present
 County in the first Monday in September (present
 month) to us directed authorizing & requiring us to
 make distribution of the Estate of the late John
 H. Alexander deceased among the distributees enti-
 tled to said Estate we proceeded this day to divide
 the real Estate of said deceased known as the Home Place
 in said County. There were four distributees to wit Mary C.
 Alexander widow & sister of said John H. Alexander deceased
 Mrs Sarah E. J. Dawson daughter of said deceased of full
 age, Mary P. H. Alexander daughter of said deceased of full age
 & John D. H. Alexander son of said deceased, all
 of whose interests were represented in person except John
 D. H. Alexander who was represented by his Mother &
 Natural Guardian. The shares in said land were divided
 as follows to the distributees Lot No. 1. Known as the Home Place
 containing two hundred acres to Mary C. Alexander & val-
 ued at two thousand (\$2000⁰⁰) dollars, Lot No. 2. Known as the
 Livery Place containing four hundred & twenty (420) acres to Sarah
 E. J. Dawson & valued at fifteen hundred & seventy five (\$1575⁰⁰)
 dollars, Lot No. 3. Known as the Evans Place containing three hun-
 dred & seventy two (372) acres to Mary P. H. Alexander & valued
 at sixteen hundred & seventy four (\$1674⁰⁰) dollars Lot No. 4
 known as the original tract containing four hundred & two (402)
 acres to John D. H. Alexander & valued at seventeen hundred & eight
 (1708⁵⁰) dollars. No. 1. pays to No. 2 one hundred & sixty four
 (\$164^{37 1/2}) dollars, No. 1. pays to No. 3 Sixty five
 (\$65^{57 1/2}) dollars No. 1. pays to No. 4 thirty
 (\$30^{57 1/2}) dollars.
