 or as nearly so as we could arrange it; those lot whose
 value exceeded the amount they were entitled, are to pay
 to those whose lot or shares do not equal the amount
 of each distributive share the surplus or due, to the smaller
 lot or shares. M. A. M. Postick, widow and relict of said
 L. B. Postick, was by the Will of said L. B. entitled to
 make her choice of lots or shares, and selected Lot No. 1.
 The remaining six lots were then regularly drawn for
 by the heirs entitled to the same.
