 tion of the Estate of L. B. Postick are among the dis-
 tributees entitled to said Estate, we proceeded this day to
 the performance of that duty.

There were seven distributees to wit: M. A. M. Postick
 widow & relict of said L. B. Postick, Rhena Postick
 of deceased of full age; Charles A. M. Postick son of de-
 ceased, of full age; Mary A. Rhodes wife of Wm. G. Rhodes
 & daughter of deceased; Albert A. Postick son of deceased
 minor; Julia C. Postick and Emma Lavinia Postick
 minor daughters of said deceased and represented by M.
 A. M. Postick their Guardian duly appointed by the Judge
 Court. The negro slaves belonging to said Estate were di-
 vided, the land and perishable property is to be otherwise
 disposed of. The negroes were placed in seven lots or
 parcels corresponding with the number of distributees
 entitled to the same; each lot of the same value
 or as nearly so as we could arrange it; those lots whose
 value exceeded the amount they were entitled to pay
 to those whose lots or shares do not equal the amount
 of each distributive share the surplus is due to the smaller
 lots or shares. M. A. M. Postick, widow and relict of said
 L. B. Postick, was by the will of said L. B. entitled to
 make her choice of lots or shares, and selected Lot No. 1
 The remaining six lots were then regularly drawn for
 by the heirs entitled to the same.
