Georgia, By virtue of an order from the
Jefferson County, Honorable Court of Ordinary of said
County on the first Monday in December last past was
directed authorizing & requiring us to make distribu-
tion of the Negro Estate of the late Green M. Turner de-
ceased. Among the distributives, entitled to said Estate, we
proceeded this day to the performance of that duty. There
were three distributives, viz. Miss Mary Turner the daugh-
ter of said Green M. Turner deceased. Mary Wendell Tur-
ner, and Noah Turner minor children of said deceased whose
interests in said distribution were represented by Abra-
ham Youngblood Guardian of said minors. The shares
were numbered one, two & three (1, 2 & 3) and were assigned
to the distributives in the following manner to wit. The
names of each distributive were written on a piece of paper
& placed in a hat; each piece of paper containing one name.
The numbers were written on three other pieces of paper &
placed in another hat; the hats were both well shaken & a
name was then drawn from one hat & a number from
the other, till all were drawn. The result as follows.
