The Commissioners appointed by the Court
to make partition in Lot of land belonging
to the Estate of Robert W. Daniel in hands
Winfield M. Rogers, administrator de bonis
non with the will annexed, after having
been duly sworn, notice having been waived
proceeded to execute said will of partition
on this the Eleventh day of December Eighteen
Hundred and Sixty nine. They employed
James M. Croft as Surveyor and upon Survey
they found that the lot of land contained
Four hundred and Twenty acres, being divided
into Two Shares, gives to each Share Eighty Six
acres, after cutting off Two Hundred acres
as the Legacy of Mary F. Rivers formerly
Mary F. Daniel as will appear by the annexed
plat of the Survey, and that Lot be valued as
following No 1 drawn by W. Russell Daniel
and valued at Five Hundred Dollars. No 2
drawn by Alice E. Daniel and valued at
Four Hundred and fifty Dollars. No 3 drawn
by Julia R. Smith and valued at Seven
Hundred Dollars. No 4 drawn by James R.
Daniel and valued at Seven Hundred Dollars.
No 5 drawn by Mary G. Wilkerson, formerly
Mary G. Daniel and valued at Two Hundred
and fifty Dollars. No 4 to pay No 5 Thirty
Dollars and to No 2 Ten Dollars, and to No 1
Eighty Dollars total One hundred and twenty
Dollars to be paid by James R. Daniel.
No 3 pays to No 2 One Hundred and Twenty Dollars
to be paid by Julia R. Smith. Which partition
they judge to be in proportion to the share assigned

We the undersigned Distributors appointed for the purpose of distributing the Estate of John Ginn late of said County do hereby among the Distributors of said estate report that we proceeded to the discharge of said duty on the 25th of the present month (February) at first having given the legal notice to the parties at interest and having employed S. J. Adkins a competent Surveyor, to assist us - and having taken the oath prescribed by law, we proceeded in the following manner, there was nothing presented to us to distribute but land, and there were four distributers. We caused a Survey to be made of all the land belonging to said estate in said County, by which means we ascertained there to be (438) Four Hundred and Twenty Eight acres.

We then caused the land to be divided into four parts, as shares of (107) One Hundred & Seven acres each, and numbered One, two, three &c. and appraised the same as follows

No 1 extreme west end of Survey	\$800.00
" 2 East of same or No 1	1000.00
" 3 lying just east in dividing line	1200.00
" 4 South of No 3	1300.00
One Share	47430.00

We then proceeded to allow the same as follows

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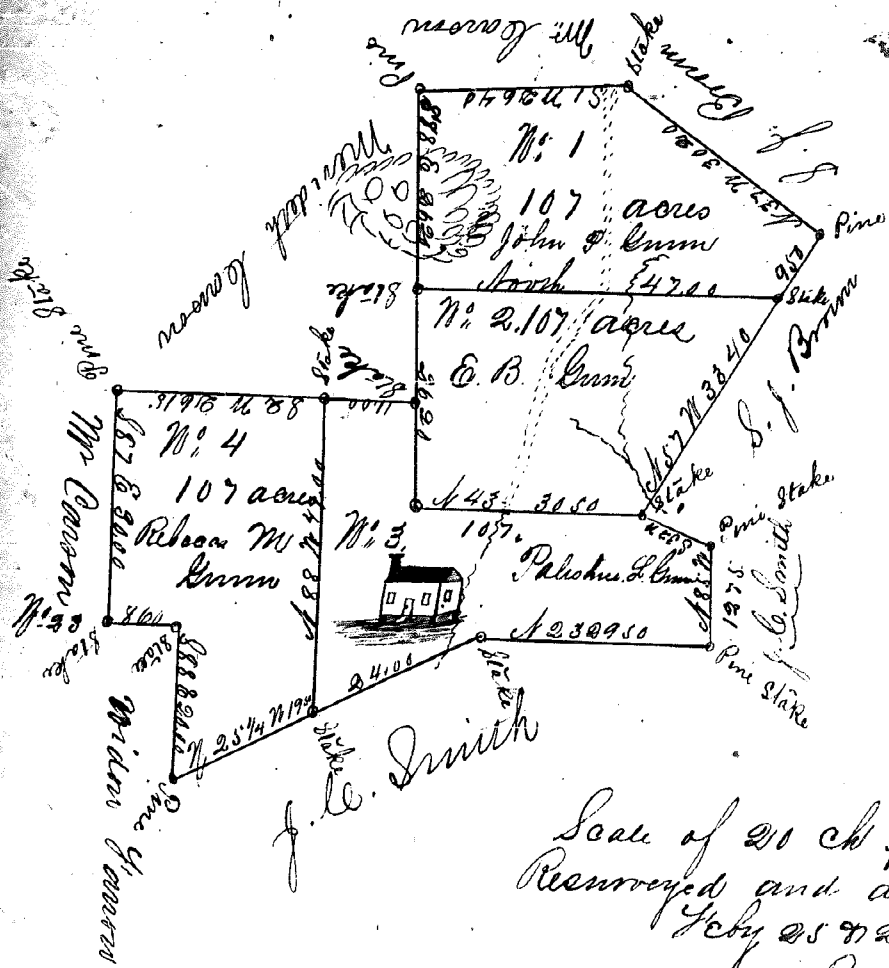
The names of the distributees were written on
separate pieces of paper and folded all of
the same size, and placed in a hat and covered.
The names of the numbers were also written
on separate pieces of paper and folded all
of the same size, and placed in the same
another hat and covered. The hats were then
well shaken, then a number was drawn from
the hat containing the numbers, and a name
from the hat containing the names, and the
result noted. Then another number was drawn
from the hat containing the numbers, and
one drawn from the hat containing the
names &c. This process was continued until
all were drawn with the following result.
