State of Georgia & By virtue of an order from the Honorable Jefferson County Court of Ordinary of said County on the first Monday of November last past to us directed authorizing and requiring us to divide the negroes in the hands of J. B. Atkins & guardian of A. J. Atkins Lincoln & Mrs Atkins and Willi. B Atkins minors children of J. B. Atkins said negroes. (Three in number) left his said minor children by their grandfather Wynn, we proceeded this day to the performance of that duty there were three distributees as above named. The shares were numbered 1. 2. 3. and were assigned to the distributees in the following manner To wit: The names of the distributees were written on a piece of paper and placed in a hat. The numbers were written on another piece of paper and put in another hat. The hats were both well shaken a name was then drawn from the hat containing the names. Then a number was drawn from the hat containing the numbers and in that manner continued till all were drawn. The following is the result:
