Jefferson County } Court of ordinary of said County on the
first Monday of November last past to us directed authorizing
and requiring us to divide the negroes in the hands of
J. B. Adkins guardian of A. J. Adkins Lucius M.
Adkins and Willie B. Adkins minors children of
J. B. Adkins said negroes. (Three in number) left to
said minor children by their Grandfather Wm. M.
proceeded this day to the performances of that duty there
were three distributies as above named. The shares were
numbered 1. 2. 3. and were assigned to the distributies in
the following manner to wit: The names of the distributies
were written on a piece of paper and placed in a hat.
The numbers were written on another piece of paper and
put in another hat. The hats were both well shaken
a name was then drawn from the hat containing the
names then a number was drawn from the hat containing
the numbers and in that manner continued till all were
drawn. The following is the result:
