 Jefferson County } the honorably the Court of Crimi-
 nary of said County on the first Monday of the present
 month, to us directed, authorizing and requiring us
 to lay off a portion of the Land belonging to the Es-
 tate of Jesse W. Clark Stapleton-deceased, to George
 L. Stapleton one of the heirs and distributees of said Es-
 tate and affix a valuation to the same, we proceed
 this day to the performance of that duty, after hav-
 ing been duly sworn according to Law in such case
 directed. One of our number being a surveyor
 (J. F. Adkins,) we caused him to do what sur-
 veying was necessary, The Administrator of
 said Estate furnished us with a plat of the
 Lands belonging to said Estate containing
 hundred and ninety seven (197) acres, we
 proceeded to lay off (76) twenty six acres off of
 the east end, of said tract of Land and as-
 signed the same to the said George L. Stapleton

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
